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Figure S1 – Dose-response curves of active EtOAc extracts in PTP1B assay. Each point represents the average of triplicate measurements.

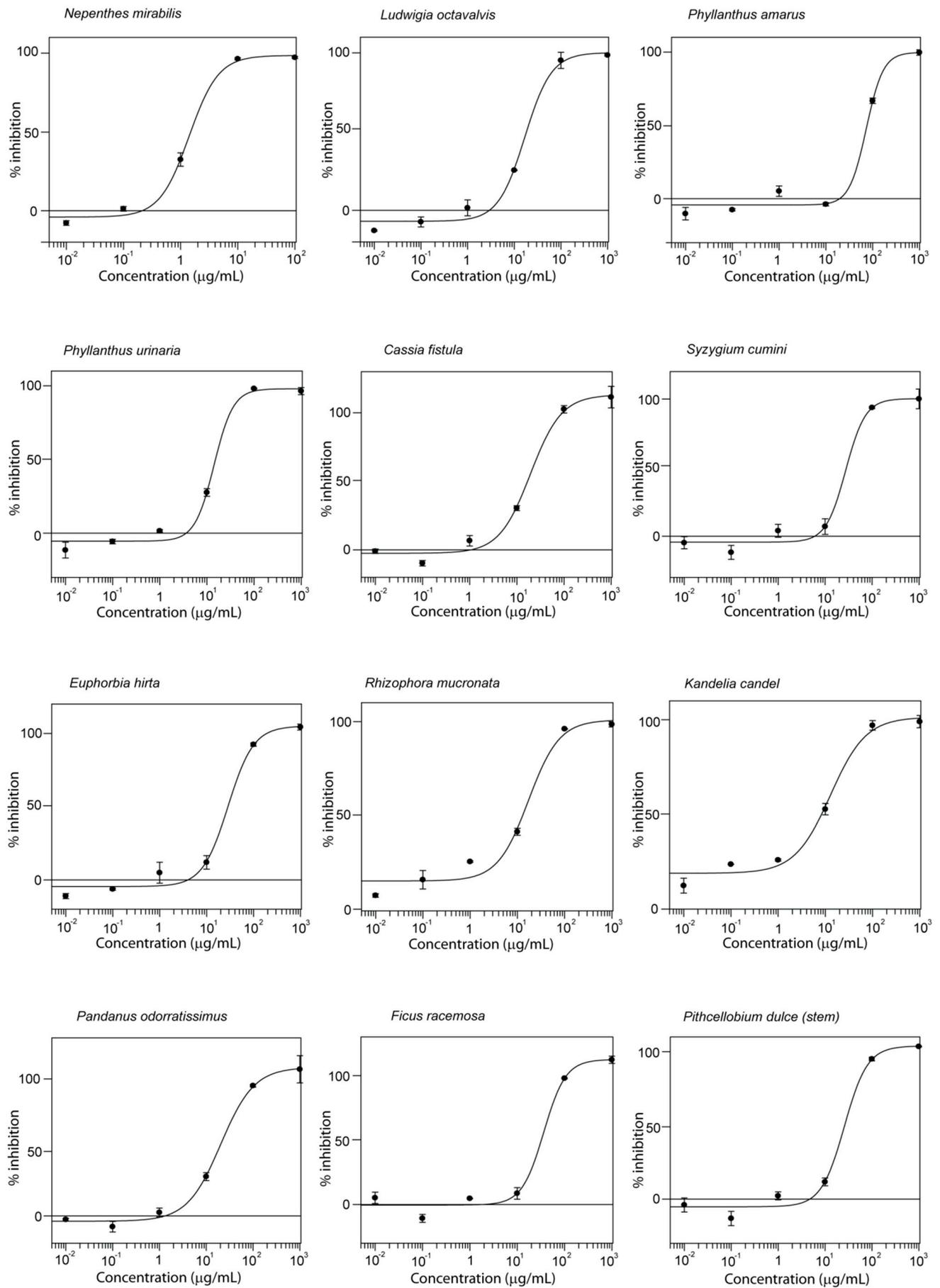


Figure S2 – Dose-response curves of active *n*-BuOH extracts in PTP1B assay. Each point represents the average of triplicate measurements.

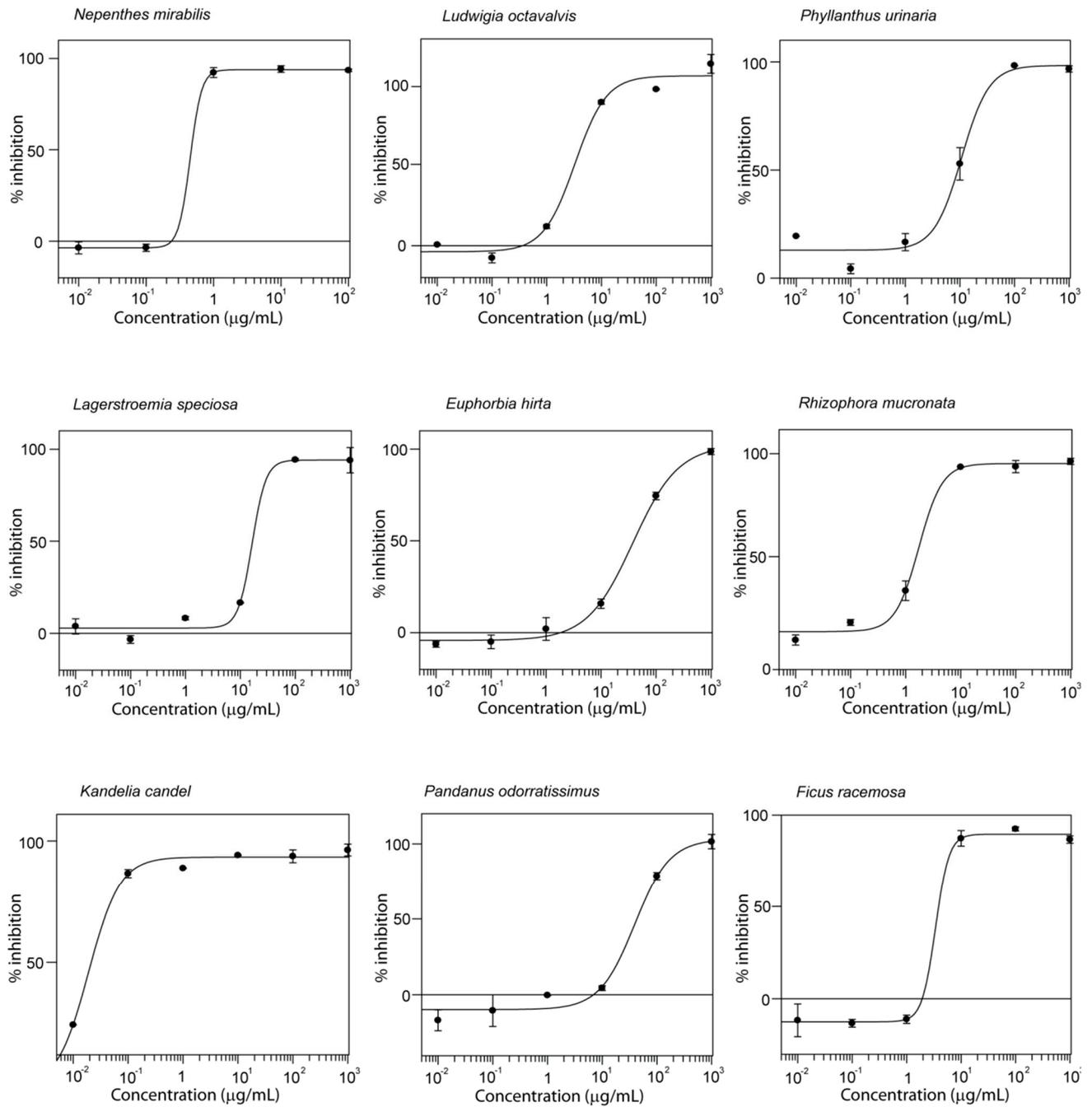
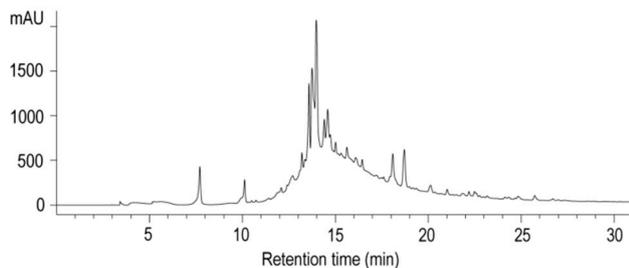
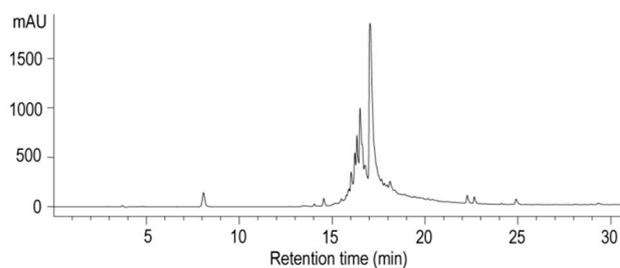


Figure S3 – UV chromatograms monitored at 254 nm of active EtOAc extracts in PTP1B assay.

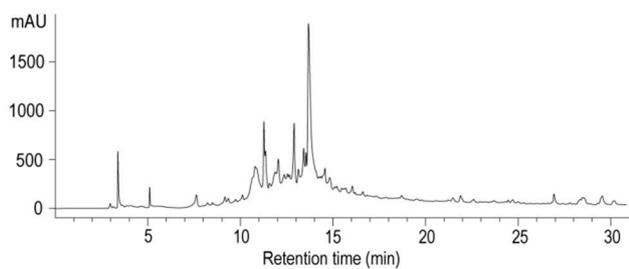

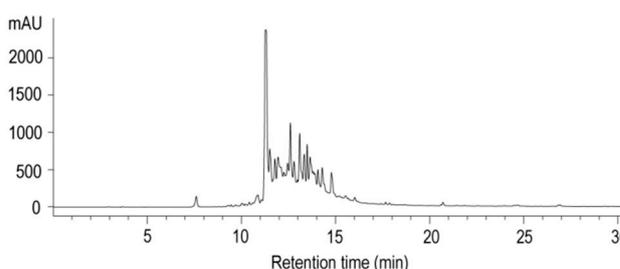

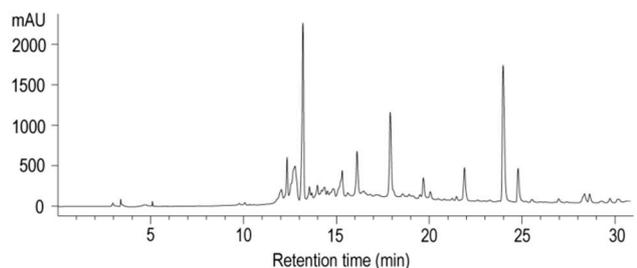

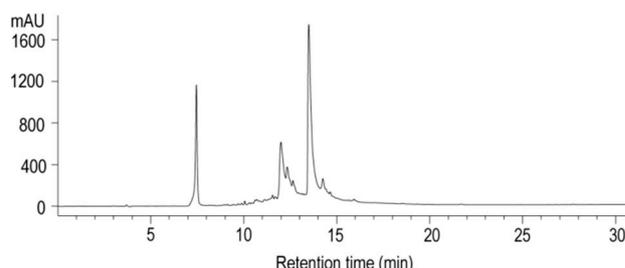

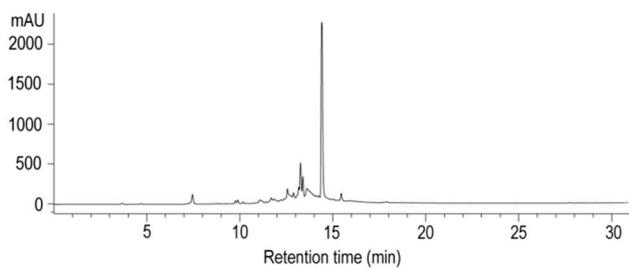

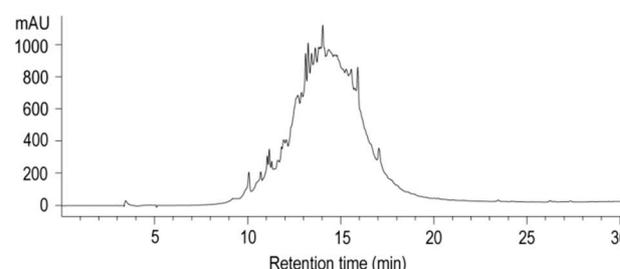

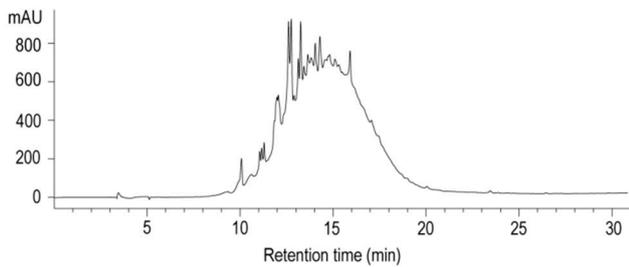

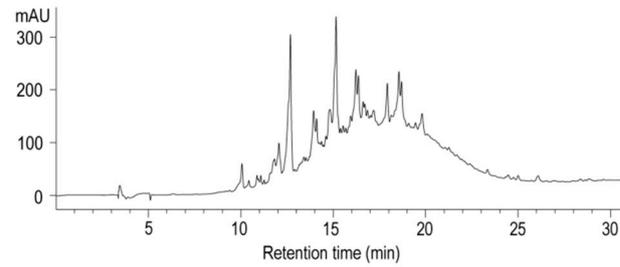

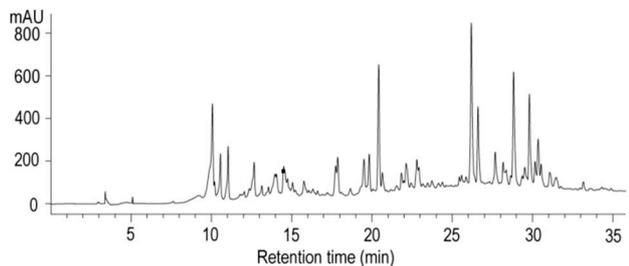

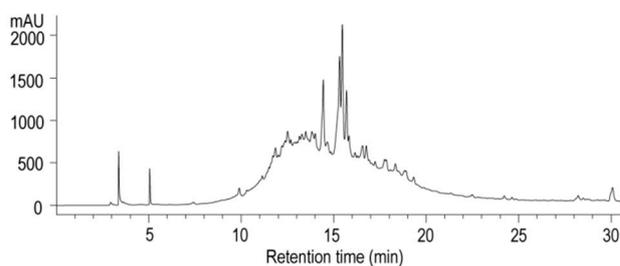


Figure S4 – UV chromatograms monitored at 254 nm of active *n*-BuOH extracts in PTP1B assay.

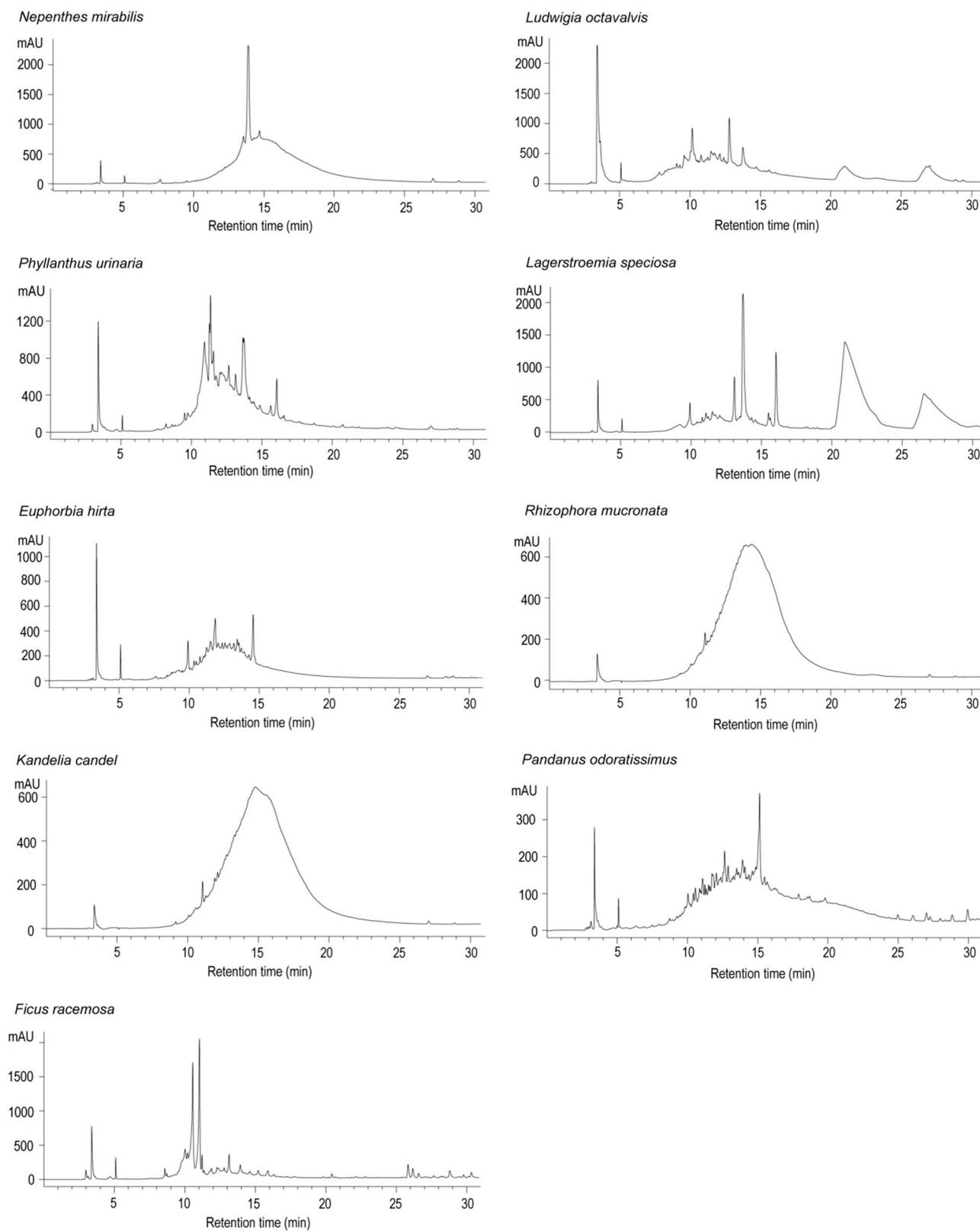


Figure S5 – HPLC trace at 254 nm and high-resolution PTP1B inhibition profile of selected active extracts.
