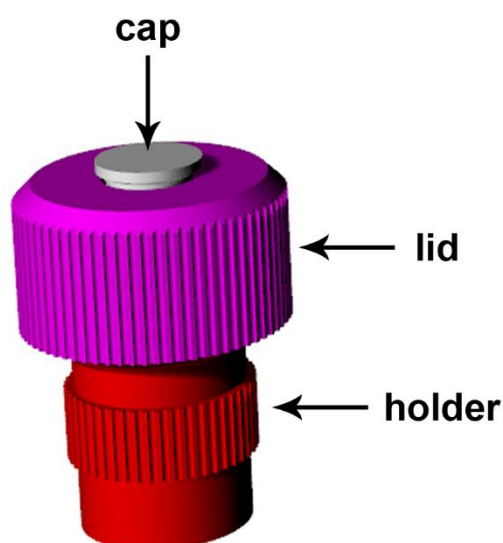


Figure S1. The cap. The CytoTrap can be furnished with the cap closing the opening of the insert during the centrifugation if necessary.

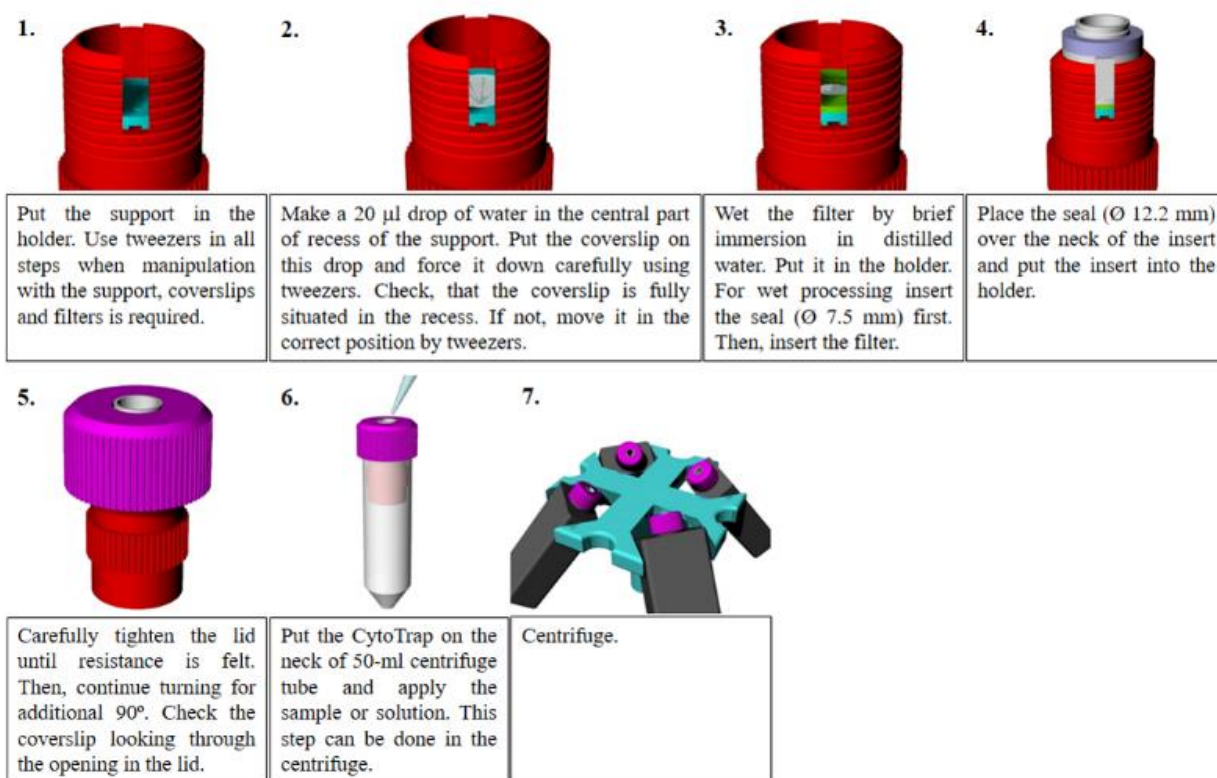


Figure S2. Description of the CytoTrap assembly. The particular steps of the CytoTrap assembly are shown.
