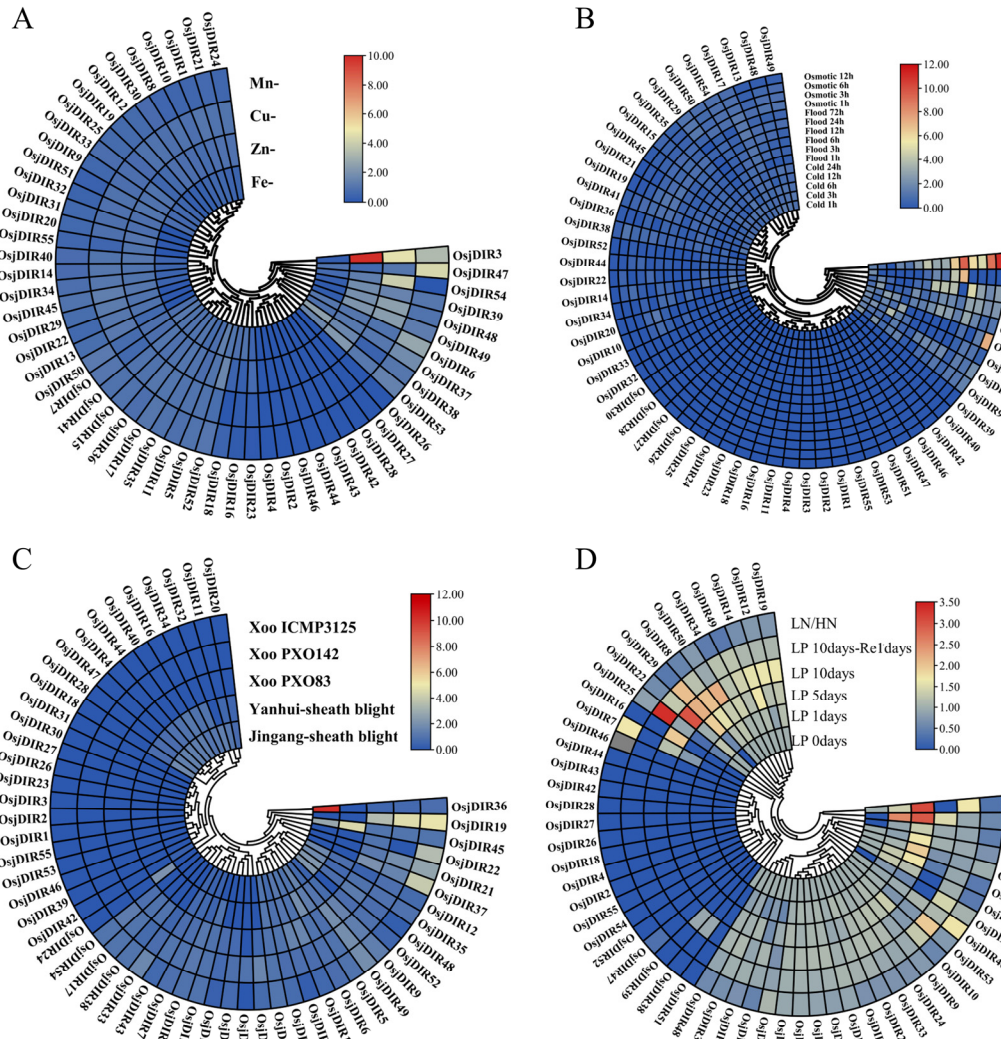
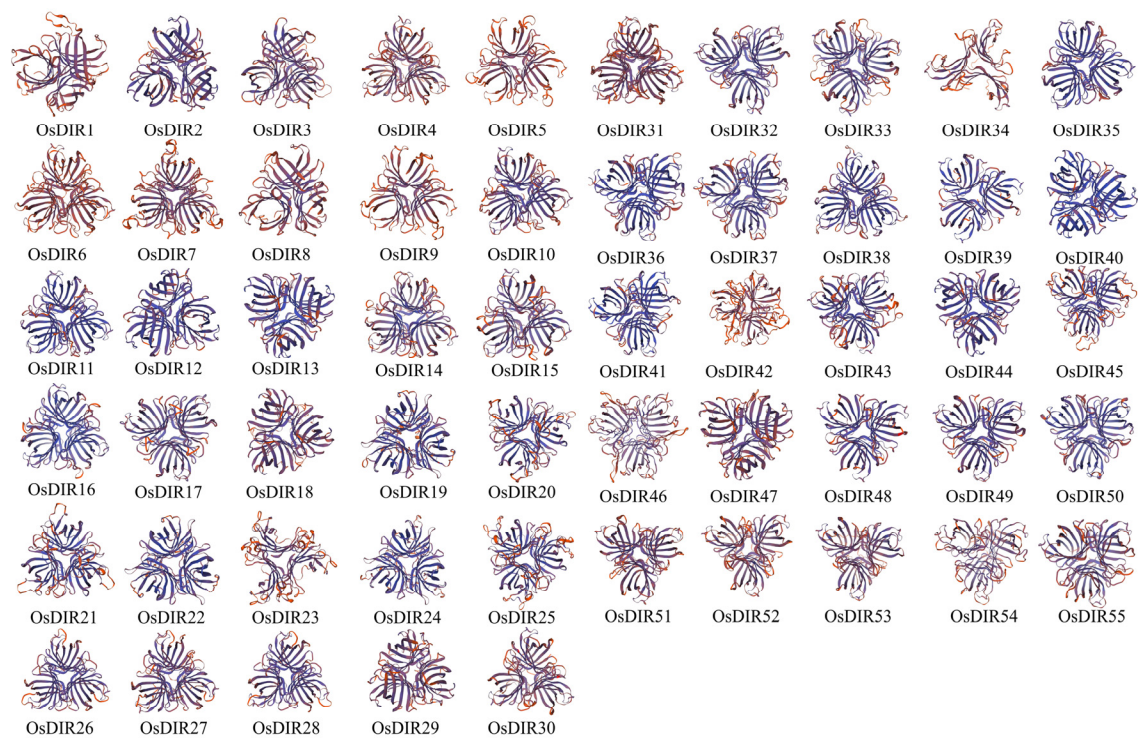


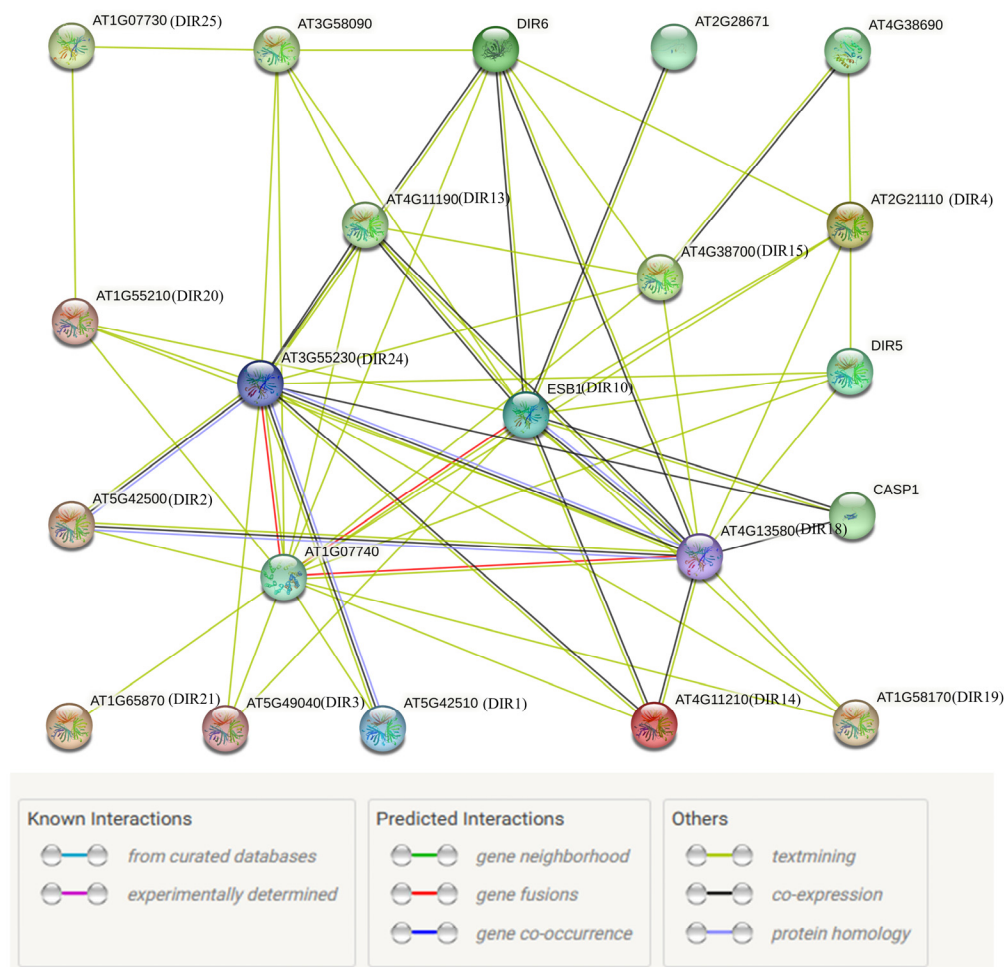
Supplemental Figure S1. Identification of transcription factor binding sites (TFBS) in the promoter regions of *OsjDIR* genes. A total 86 JASPAR matrices were selected. P-value $\leq 1E^{-7}$. Heat map represent the number of TFBS in each variety. Including secondary cell wall, light, abiotic stress, biotic stress, hormones and development. The heatmap was constructed by Tbtools software.



Supplemental Figure S2. Expression profiles of the *OsjDIR* genes in response to the biotic and abiotic stresses based on the RNA-seq data. (A) The heat map exhibited the relative expression levels of *OsjDIR* genes in response to nutrient elements deficiency (Mn-, Cu-, Zn-, Fe-) treatments. (B) The heat map exhibited the relative expression of *OsjDIR* genes in response to osmotic, flood and cold stress. (C) The heat map exhibited the expression of *OsjDIR* genes in response to Xoo and sheath blight infection.
