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

(A) Product ion spectra of the D3G standard (1000 ng/mL); (B–I) product ion spectra of the precursor ion (m/z 517.1927) with the same chromatographic retention time as the D3G standard in samples of dual culture test: *F. graminearum* 5035 grew against *T. harzianum* JF309 (B); *T. harzianum* GIM3.442 (C); *T. koningii* GIM3.137 (D); *T. longibrachiatum* GIM3.534 (E); *T. harzianum* Q710613 (F); *T. atroviride* Q710251 (G); *T. asperellum* Q710682 (H); and *T. virens* Q710925 (I).
