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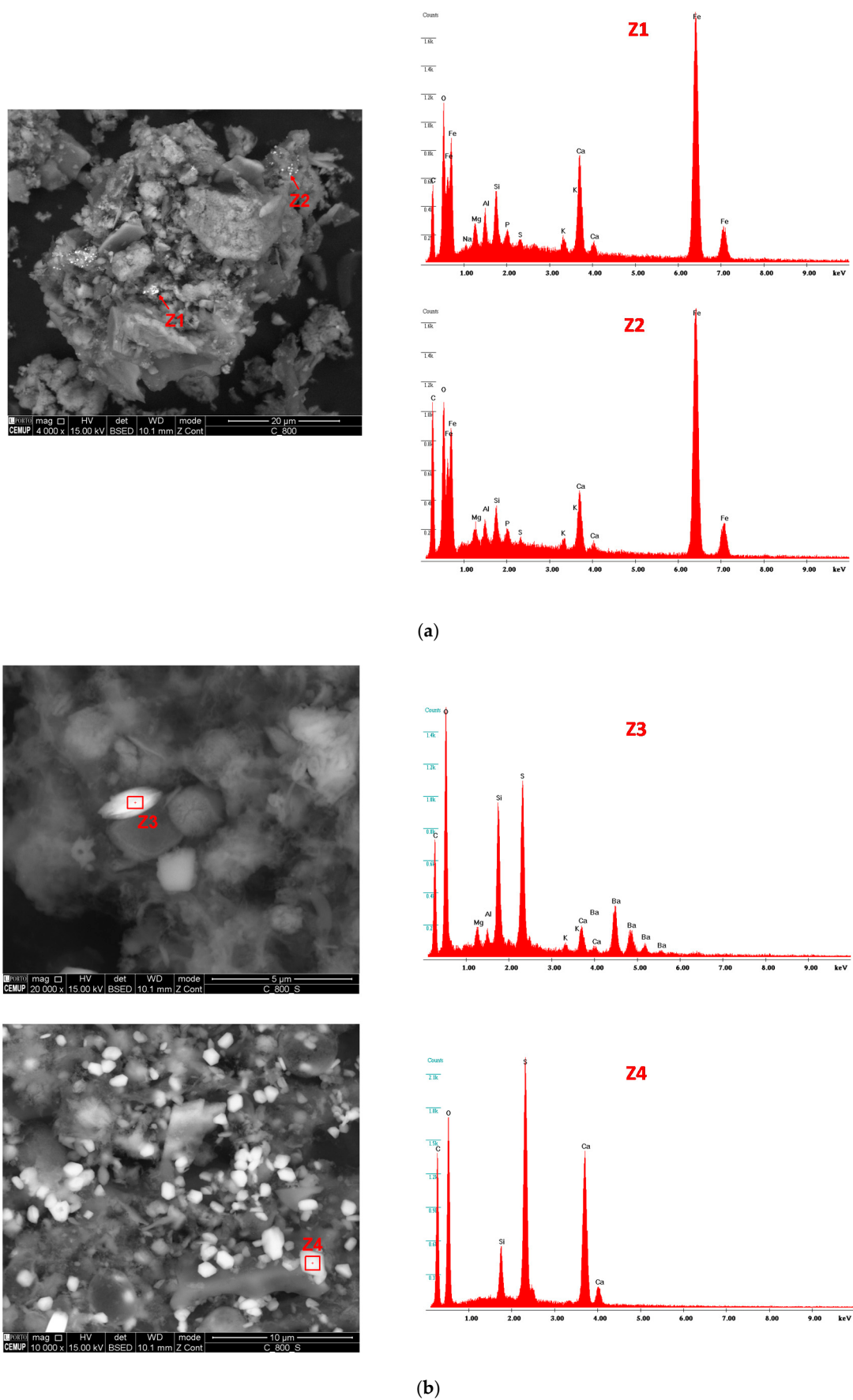


Figure S1. SEM micrographs and corresponding EDS spectra of C-800 (a) and C-800-S (b).
