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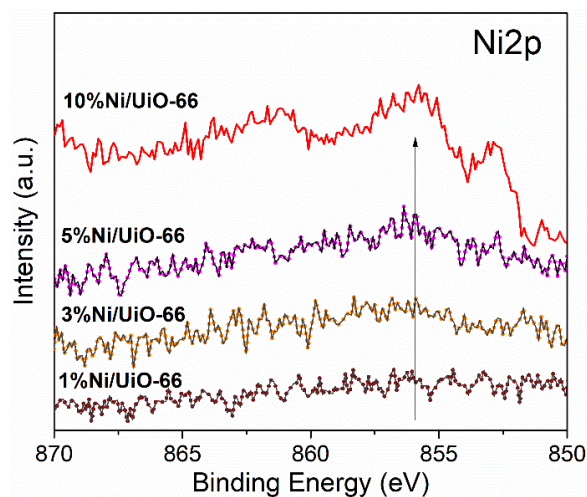


Figure S1. Ni 2p XPS spectra of the nickel modified samples, including the 10%Ni/Uio-66 material.

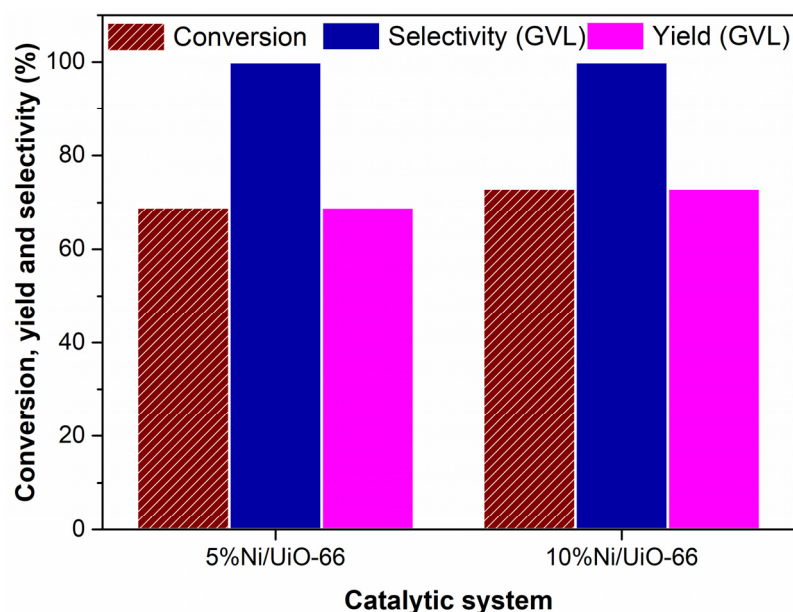
