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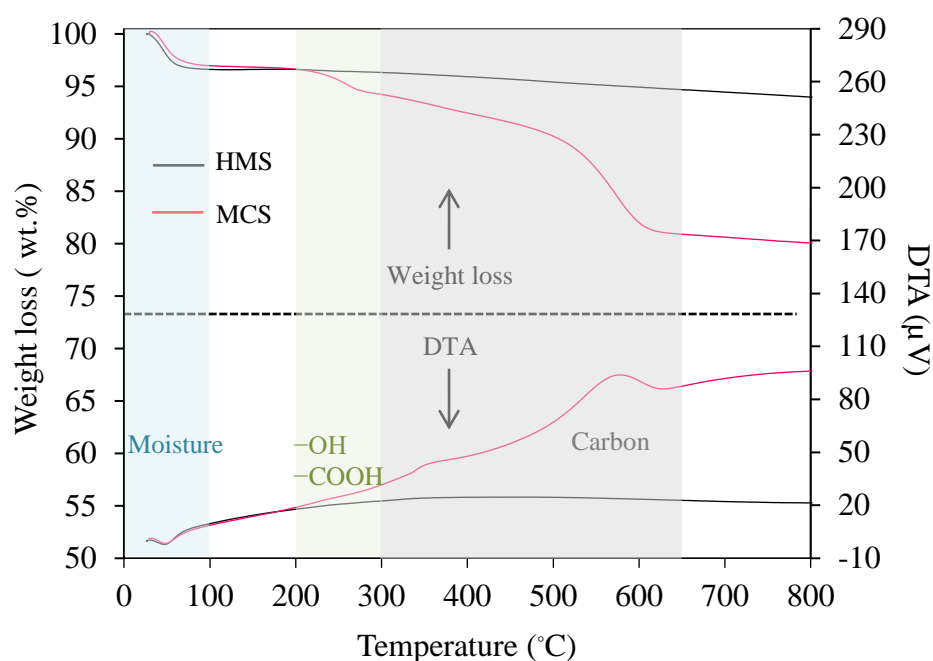


Figure S1. Weight loss and DTA curves of pure silica HMS and MCS nanocomposite.

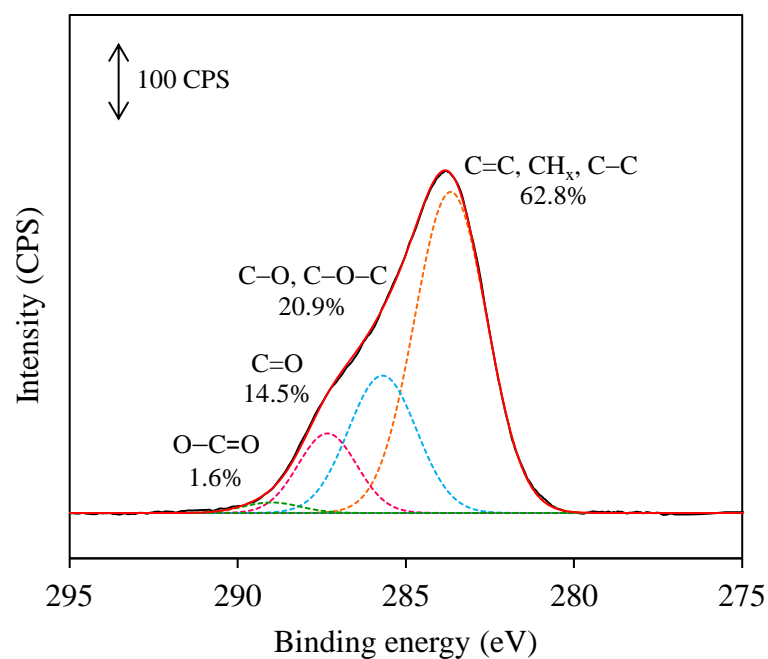


Figure S2. C1s XPS spectrum of MCS nanocomposite.

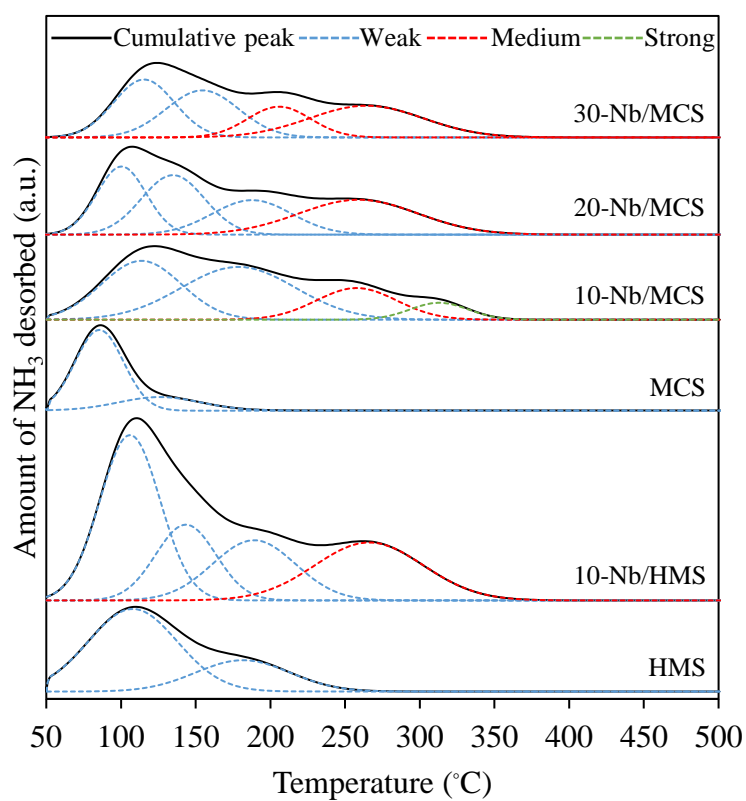


Figure S3. NH₃-TPD profiles of HMS and MCS with different Nb loading amount.
