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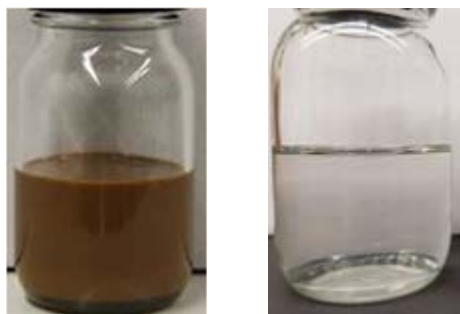

Figure S1. Pictures of Repolyol (a) and reference polyol Voranol 3322 (b)

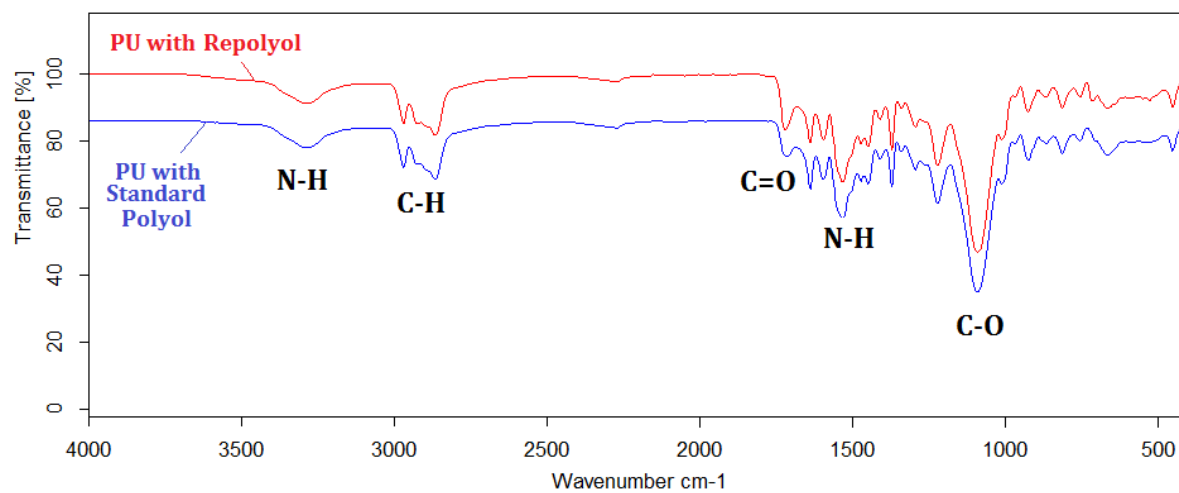


Figure S2. FTIR spectra of the polyurethane foams obtained with Repolyol (red line) and reference polyol (Voranol 3322, blue line)
