


Figure S1: Cleared areas in hotspot A




Figure S2: Cleared areas in hotspot B




Figure S3: Cleared areas in hotspot C




Figure S4: Cleared areas in hotspot D




Figure S5: Cleared areas in hotspot E




Figure S6: Areas in hotspot A that have never been cleared since their initial invasion




Figure S7: Areas in hotspot B that have never been cleared since their initial invasion




Figure S8: Areas in hotspot C that have never been cleared since their initial invasion




Figure S9: Areas in hotspot D that have never been cleared since their initial invasion




Figure S10: Areas in hotspot E that have never been cleared since their initial invasion




Figure S11: Areas in hotspot A that were cleared but re-invaded




Figure S12: Areas in hotspot B that were cleared but re-invaded




Figure S13: Areas in hotspot C that were cleared but re-invaded




Figure S14: Areas in hotspot D that were cleared but re-invaded




Figure S15: Areas in hotspot E that were cleared but re-invaded
