

This data represents the number of referral orders to clinical genetics by specialty (with number of departments within a specialty in parentheses) at Sanford Health by year from January 01, 2013 to December 31, 2020. Referral rates in 2020 may have been impacted by the pandemic. In addition, Breast Clinic referral orders did not always experience growth, but this could be due the Athena program that began in 2016 [46]. The Athena program identified high risk patients via questionnaire at time of mammogram with recommendation for genetic counseling if indicated in the mammogram report. Internal Medicine referral orders only went down when the number of departments went down which was likely impacted by staffing changes.
