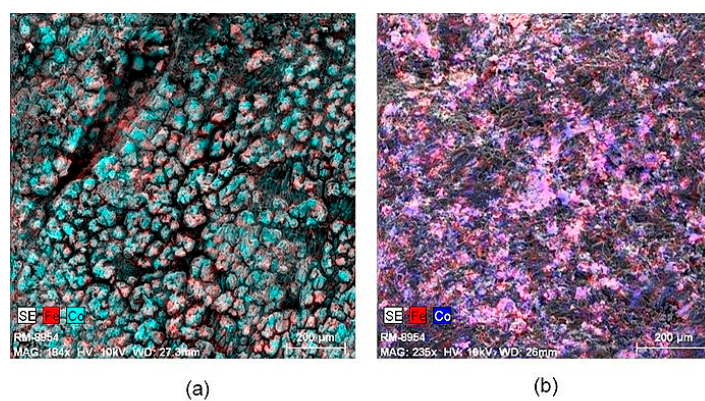

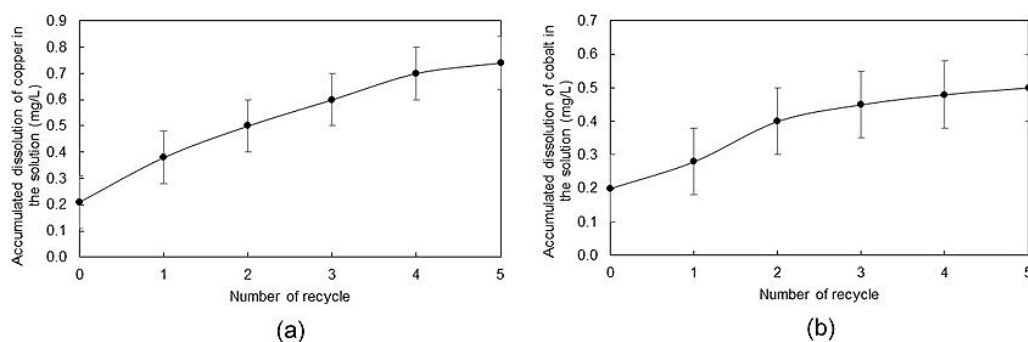


Figure S2. Accumulated dissolution of copper and cobalt in the cyanide solution after five oxidation essays.
