Opportunities to Thrive [6]

- Opportunity for a thoughtfully presented, well-balanced diet: A suitable, speciesspecific diet will be provided in a way that ensures full health and vigor, both behaviorally and physically.
- 2. Opportunity to self-maintain: An appropriate environment including shelter and species-specific substrates that encourage opportunities to self-maintain.
- Opportunity for optimal health: Rapid diagnosis and treatment of injury or disease while providing supportive environments that increase the likelihood of healthy individuals.
- 4. Opportunity to express species-specific behavior: Quality spaces and appropriate social groupings will be provided that encourage species-specific behaviors at natural frequencies and of appropriate diversity while meeting social and developmental needs of each species in the collection.
- Opportunities for choice and control: Providing conditions in which animals can exercise control and make choices to avoid suffering and distress, and make behavior meaningful.
