






Figure S2: The complete original immunoblots shown in Figure 9 are presented in order below. The individual parts comprising Figure 9 are specified using black boxes.






Figure S3: The complete original immunoblots shown in Figure 9 are presented in order below. The individual parts comprising Figure 9 are specified using black boxes.






Figure S4: The complete original immunoblots shown in Figure 11 are presented in order below. The individual parts comprising Figure 11 are specified using black boxes.
