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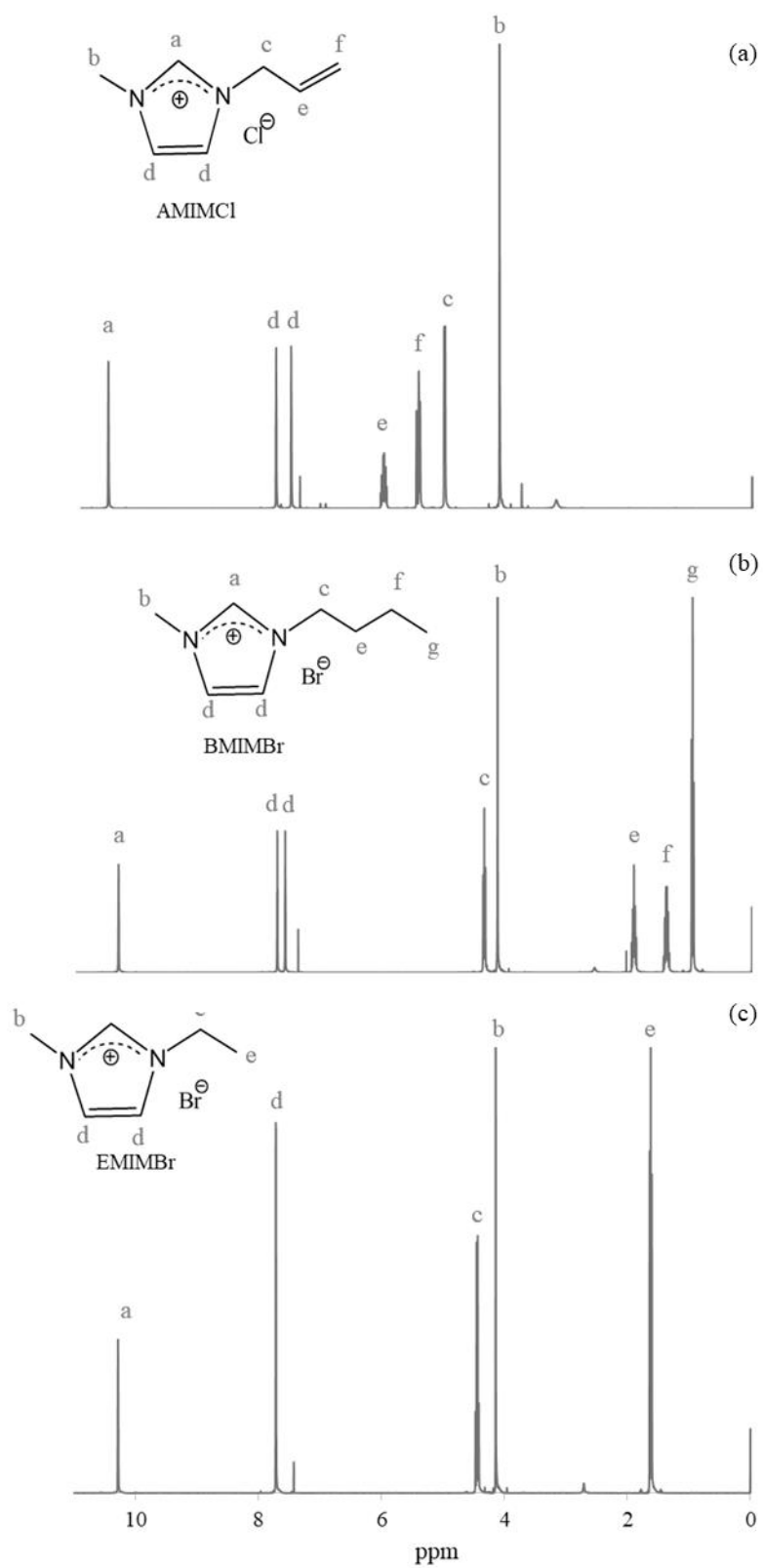


Figure S1. ^1H NMR spectra of (a) AMIMCl, (b) BMIMBr, and (c) EMIMBr in CDCl_3 .

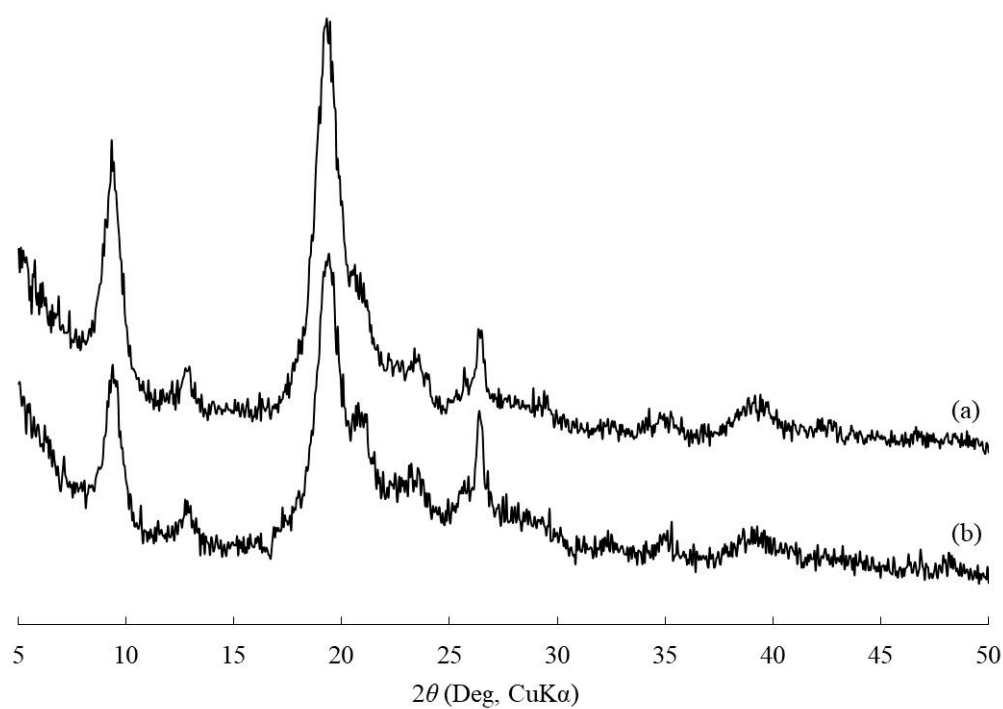


Figure S2. XRD profiles of (a) original chitin and (b) regenerated chitin.

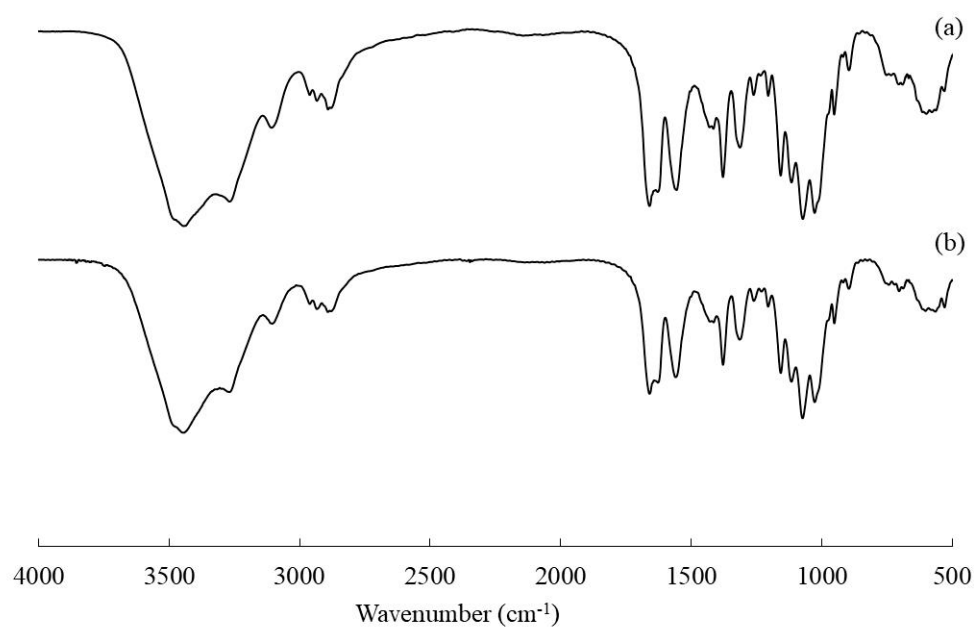


Figure S3. IR spectra of (a) original chitin and (b) regenerated chitin.



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
