Antibiotic residues have a negative impact on public health and food safety with regard to drug toxicity, immunopathological diseases, carcinogenicity, allergic reactions, etc., whereas antibiotic resistant bacteria lead to treatment failure in human and animal, increasing the number of infections worldwide.
