Dr. Salas-Huetos (MSc, PhD) is an Assistant Professor of the Department of Basic Medical Sciences (Unitat de Medicina Preventiva i Salut Pública) at Rovira i Virgili University, Reus, Spain. Dr. Salas-Huetos's research interests are mainly focused on male/female infertility and exposome (nutrition, endocrine disruptors, pollution, age, adiposity, etc.). He has been working in several randomized clinical trials, large cohort prospective studies, and hot topic meta-analyses. Dr. Salas-Huetos received his PhD in 2016 and has an outstanding publication record, comprising 83 publications in peer-reviewed international journals and 5 book chapters. Salas-Huetos's Scopus Scientific Citations number is 1698 and his Hirsch index is 22. He is clearly a rising star in the field of nutrition and (in)fertility. As a single applicant, Dr. Salas-Huetos has secured funding of more than EUR 120k since 2023. This is an outstanding achievement in today's competitive environment.
