As Editor-in-Chief of *Bioengineering*, I am pleased to announce the winner of the *Bioengineering Travel Award 2018* for researchers. **Dr. Lizette Utomo**, a postdoctoral researcher at the Department of Oral and Maxillofacial Surgery and Special Dental Care, University Medical Center Utrecht, Utrecht, the Netherlands, received this award. She investigates the potential use of dental pulp stem cells (DPSCs) for the generation of the temporomandibular joint tissue engineering, and more specifically, the mandibular condyle. At the moment, she is working on generating different cartilage zones by combining DPSCs and 3D biomaterials. This will be incorporated into a mandibular condyle construct.
