Scope

Biologics are products of living systems. This journal addresses all aspects of the therapeutic use of biologics, as well as companion diagnostics meant to determine patients most likely to benefit from these agents. Biologics include synthetic products that are chemically similar to the natural product, such as modified recombinant proteins.
