Dear Colleagues,

We are pleased to announce that *Biology* is now inviting nominations for the *Biology* 2023 Young Investigator Award. This prize will be awarded to two young investigators in recognition of their excellence in the field of biological science. All nominations will be assessed by an Award Evaluation Committee led by the Editors-in-Chief, Prof. Dr. Jukka Finne and Prof. Dr. Andrés Moya.

The prize:

- Rank 1 award (one awardee): CHF 2000 and a chance to publish a paper free of charge in *Biology* in 2023;
- Rank 2 award (one awardee): CHF 1500 and a chance to publish a paper free of charge in *Biology* in 2023.

Eligibility and Requirements:

- Must have received their PhD no more than 10 years prior to 30 May 2023;
- Must have produced ground-breaking research and made a significant contribution to the advancement of biological science;
- Candidates must be nominated by senior scientists.

List of Documents for Nomination:

- Detailed Curriculum Vitae, including an updated publication list and a list of the researcher's own research grants;
- Scanned copy of doctorate certificate;
- Signed nomination letters from two established senior scientists.

Schedule:

- Nominations opening: 15 December 2022
- Nomination deadline: 30 May 2023
- Winners' announcement: 31 July 2023
