Prof. Dr. Stefano Cinti received his PhD in 2015 and has an outstanding publication record, comprising 70 articles, 6 chapters in books, and 2 proceedings, with an H-Index of 31. He is clearly a rising star in the field of biosensors. As a single applicant, Prof. Stefano Cinti has secured funding of more than EUR 752k since 2017.
