Dr. Alessandra Borsini's research interests include the brain, inflammation, and mental health. Dr. Alessandra Borsini received her Ph.D. in 2017 and has an outstanding publication record, comprising 93 publications in peer-reviewed international journals. Dr. Alessandra Borsini's Scopus scientific citations number is 1425 and her Hirsch index is 20. She is clearly a rising star in the field of neuroimmunopsychiatry. Dr. Daniele Bertoglio is a tenure-track assistant professor at the Bio-Imaging Lab (BIL), Faculty of Pharmaceutical, Biomedical and Veterinary Sciences at the University of Antwerp.
