Dear Colleagues,

Radiology plays a pivotal in the diagnostic, treatment, and follow-up of cancers. At the same time, with the expansion of therapeutic options, interventional radiology is playing a growing part in the curative and palliative management of cancers. Tailored treatment strategies are becoming increasingly available for patients, with a dramatically increasing role of imaging and especially radiomics in the pretreatment assessment of patients as well as follow-up after treatments.
