Surgery remains the potentially curative treatment for pancreatic ductal adenocarcinoma (PDAC) without metastases, and en bloc resection with adequate surgical margins is associated with long-term survival. Venous invasion does not preclude patients from surgery because combined venous resection and reconstitution can be safely performed. In the age of molecularly-targeted drugs and immunotherapy, researchers put great efforts based on genomics and proteomics of PDAC into finding the best targeted therapy.
