We are pleased to announce that *Children* is now inviting nominations for the *Children* 2022 Young Investigator Award. This prize will be awarded to one young investigator in recognition of their excellence in the dissemination of clinical, epidemiological, and translational science relevant to children's health. All nominations will be assessed by the award evaluation committee, which will be led by the Editor-in-Chief Prof. Dr. Paul R. Carney.

The prize:

- CHF 2000;
- Option to publish one paper, free of charge, in *Children* before the end of 2023, following peer review;
- An engraved plaque.

Eligibility and Requirements:

- Must have a Ph.D. degree;
- Must be below 35 years of age by 31 December 2022;
- Must have produced ground-breaking research and made a significant contribution to the advancement of the research field;
- Candidates must be nominated by senior scientists.

List of Documents for Nomination

- Detailed curriculum vitae, including an updated publication list and a list of the researcher's own research grants;
- Birth certificate or other proof of age;
- Scanned copy of doctorate certificate;
- Signed nomination letters from two established senior scientists.

Schedule

- Open for nominations: 1 July 2022

- Nomination deadline: 30 June 2023

Winner announcement: 30 September 2023
