2023 YOUNG INVESTIGATOR AWARD

The Prize

- CHF 2000;
- Option to publish one paper, as a corresponding author, free of charge in *Electronics* in 2023, following peer review;
- An electronic certificate.

Eligibility and Requirements

- Must have received their PhD no more than 10 years prior to 31 December 2023;
- Must have produced ground-breaking research and made a significant contribution to the advancement of electronics;
- Candidates must be nominated by senior scientists.

List of Documents for Nomination

- Detailed curriculum vitae, including an updated publication list and a list of the researcher's own research grants;
- Scanned copy of doctorate certificate;
- Signed nomination letters from two established senior scientists.

Schedule

- Open for nominations: 1 December 2022;
- Nominations deadline: 30 September 2023;
- Winner announcement: end of November 2023.
