The Prize

- CHF 1000;
- The option to publish one paper free of charge in Genes after peer review before the end of 2024;
- An electronic certificate.

Eligibility and Requirements

- Must have received their PhD no more than 10 years prior to 31 December
- Must have produced ground-breaking research and made a significant contribution to the advancement of genetics and genomics;
- Candidates must be nominated by senior scientists.

List of Documents for Nomination

- Detailed Curriculum Vitae, including an updated publication list and a list of the researcher's own research grants;
- Scanned copy of doctorate certificate;
- Signed nomination letters from two established senior scientists.

Schedule

Open for nominations: 31 March 2023. Nomination deadline: 30 November 2023. Winner announcement: 31 January 2024.
