The role of stress hormones and other hormonal compounds in the clinical presentation (phenotype) and response to treatment will also be explored. Evidence for the effectiveness of pharmacological and non-pharmacological interventions to treat schizophrenia and related disorders is also welcome, with a special emphasis on treatments targeting emotions and cognitive symptoms. The impact of physical health on psychotic symptoms and vice versa is also a topic of interest in psychotic populations.
