We are pleased to announce that *Horticulturae* is now inviting nominations for the *Horticulturae* 2023 Young Investigator Award. This prize will be given to one young investigator in recognition of their excellence in the field of *Horticulture* Sciences. All nominations will be assessed by an Award Evaluation Committee led by the Editor-in-Chief, Prof. Dr. Luigi De Bellis.

The prize:

- CHF 1500;
- Option to publish one paper free of charge in *Horticulturae* after peer review before the end of 31 December 2023;
- An electronic certificate.

Eligibility and Requirements:

Candidates must:

- Have received their PhD no more than 10 years prior to 31 December 2023;
- Have produced ground-breaking research and made a significant contribution to the advancement of Horticulture Sciences;
- Be nominated by senior scientists, research directors, or department heads.

List of Documents for Nomination:

- Detailed curriculum vitae, including an updated publication list and a list of the researcher's own research grants;
- Scanned copy of doctorate certificate;
- Signed nomination letters from two established senior scientists.

Schedule:

- Open for nominations: 30 July 2022
- Nomination deadline: 31 March 2023
- Winner announcement: 31 May 2023
