His current work centers on determining cost-effective interventions, assessing health service innovations, and strengthening health systems. Dr. Tran received his Ph.D. degree in 2011 and worked as a postdoctoral research fellow (2012–2013) at the University of Alberta. Dr. Tran's track record of achievements is impressive for a young investigator at this stage of his career. So far, he has published more than 180 papers and has delivered over 50 invited presentations.
