As telerehabilitation is increasingly being implemented across patient groups, the research on the patient perspective of telerehabilitation has been fragmented and sparse. This Special Issue welcomes studies or reviews of various telerehabilitation formats, either planned or acute implementations due to COVID-19 pandemic. We are particularly interested in studies:

- (i) addressing how telerehabilitation aims to overcome participation and adherence barriers,
- (ii) focusing on how patients engage with various types of technology,
- (iii) comparing the patients' experience of conventional rehabilitation compared to telerehabilitation,
- (iv) focusing on how telerehabilitation may expand our understanding of what telerehabilitation could entail.

Studies combining two or more of these aims may be of special interest.
