On behalf of the Evaluation Committee, I am pleased to announce the winner of the 2017 *Inorganics* Travel Award. This award was granted to **Daniel Franz**, a postdoc researcher in Professor Shigeyoshi Inoue's group at the Technical University of Munich.

Dr. Franz's research interests focus on the isolation of low-coordinate and electron deficient main group metal complexes, as well as molecular higher-coordinate metal hydrides. He is planning to present his work "Coordination chemistry and applications of N-heterocyclic imino complexes of boron and silicon" at the International Conference on Phosphorus, Boron and Silicon—PBSI 2017. The award consists of **800 Swiss Francs** towards attending this conference.
