The *Journal of Clinical Medicine* (JCM) is inviting applications for the JCM 2022 PhD Thesis Award. This prize will be awarded to a PhD student or doctor who has produced a highly anticipated academic potential thesis. The applications will be assessed by an evaluation committee led by Editors-in-Chief, Dr. Emmanuel Andrès and Prof. Dr. Michael G. Hennerici.

Eligibility and Requirements:

- The candidate must be a PhD student or a doctor who has produced a highly anticipated academic potential thesis;
- The PhD thesis must be their original work;
- The PhD thesis must be defended in 2022;
- Applicants are required to submit the following documents:
 - a. An executive summary of the PhD thesis in English of around 3000 words;
 - b. A letter from the PhD supervisor recommending the candidate for consideration for this award;
 - c. The candidate's CV, including a list of publications connected with the thesis;
 - d. An electronic copy of the PhD thesis;
 - e. A scanned copy of the PhD diploma (or certificate of studying at a school or research institute as a PhD student going to graduate or participate in graduation thesis defenses).

Selection Criteria:

- Quality of resume and publications;
- Relevance of the candidate and research description;
- Novelty of the candidate's PhD thesis;
- Strength of the recommendation letter;
- Anticipated academic potential;
- Originality and impact of the research.

Prizes:

- Bonus (CHF 800);
- Certificate;
- Offer to publish a featured paper in JCM with the article processing charge (APC) waived before the end of 2023.

The application deadline is 30 April 2023. The winner will be announced on the JCM website by the end of June 2023.
