Dear Colleagues,

Surgically determined treatment and care of gastric cancer has experienced development for more than 15 years.

The implementation of neoadjuvant chemotherapy has led to substantial progress in surgical therapy and its early postoperative and long-term oncosurgical outcome. In addition, surgical specimens and tumor tissue have been better characterized step-by-step.

From a surgical point of view, the surgical potential of recurrent and metastatic tumor growth (i.e., hepatic and peritoneal metastases) as well as prospects for palliative tumor resections have become of great interest in the surgical community. Furthermore, multi-modal treatment concepts as well as gender- and BMI-dependent specifics may be of particular interest with regard to patient-, diagnosis-, tumor tissue- and surgical treatment-associated characteristics (such as perioperative factors and parameters). All the mentioned aspects are potential topics of interest for this Special Issue. We invite the submission of papers focusing on:

Evaluating original data;
Summarizing and discussing available data by means of a meta-analysis, systematic or narrative reviews.
