Message from the Guest Editors

It is our pleasure to invite you and members of your research group to submit an article for a Special Issue titled "Recent Advances in Pancreatic Neoplasms: Part II". This volume follows on from the previous one, in which 14 papers were published.

Pancreatic cancer is the fourth leading cause of cancer death in Western countries, and will soon become the second leading cause of gastrointestinal cancer death. Surgery and adjuvant therapy remains the standard treatment, but the recurrence rate remains high. Multimodality treatment, that is, neoadjuvant therapy and a combination of chemotherapy, radiotherapy, immunotherapy, and surgery, appears to be essential to obtain better results, but definitive conclusions on its effectiveness are lacking. This Special Issue is focused on the latest developments and challenges in multimodality therapy for resectable and locally advanced pancreatic tumors, the search for prognostic factors for early and late outcomes after therapy, and the evaluation of novel strategies for individualized treatment. We invite relevant original research, systematic reviews, meta-analyses, and short communications covering the above-mentioned topics.





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
