The symptoms of urticaria are undoubtedly the cause of distress for patients, having a detrimental influence on patients' quality of life and resulting in emotional disturbances. Previous analyses proved significant psychological and psychiatric comorbidity in the course of urticaria. Accompanying pruritus often disturbs the sleep cycle. Recurrent angioedema, often coexisting with wheals, is an important problem in daily practice and emergency medicine and one of the most important symptoms of urticaria.
