The Journal of Clinical Medicine is planning a Special Issue, "Pharmacological Management of Chronic Pain". In the last 30 years, pharmacotherapy in many countries, and particularly in North America, has been largely dominated by opioids. For this Special Issue, we are interested in clinical, epidemiological studies and systematic reviews with a focus on pharmacotherapy, pharmacology, pharmacokinetics, pharmacoepidemiology, pharmacogenomics, drug efficacy and safety, related education for healthcare professionals, policy and program research.













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
