We are pleased to announce that *Journal of Fungi* is now inviting nominations for the *JoF* 2023 Young Investigator Award. This prize will be given to three young investigators in recognition of their excellence in the field of mycology. All nominations will be assessed by an Award Evaluation Committee led by the Editor-in-Chief, Prof. Dr. David S. Perlin.

The Prize

There will be three winners this year, and each will receive the following:

- CHF 1000;
- An opportunity to publish one paper free of charge in *JoF* after peer review before the end of 2024;
- An electronic certificate.

Eligibility and Requirements

- Must have received their PhD no more than 10 years prior to 31 December 2023;
- Must have produced ground-breaking research and made a significant contribution to the advancement of the research field;
- Candidates must be nominated by senior scientists.

List of Documents for Nomination

- Detailed Curriculum Vitae, including an updated publication list and a list of the researcher's own research grants;
- Scanned copy of doctorate certificate;
- Signed nomination letters from two established senior scientists.

Schedule

- Open for nominations: 15 March 2023
- Nomination deadline: 31 December 2023
- Winners announcement: 31 March 2024
