## 2023 YOUNG INVESTIGATOR AWARD

### The Prizes:

- CHF 2000;
- Option to publish one paper free of charge in *Medicina* after peer review before the end of 31 December 2024;
- An electronic certificate.

### Eligibility and Requirements for Candidates:

- Must have received their PhD no more than 10 years prior to 31 December 2023;
- Must have produced ground-breaking research and made a significant contribution to the advancement of medical;
- Must be nominated by senior scientists.

### List of Documents for Nomination:

- Detailed Curriculum Vitae, including an updated publication list and a list of the researcher's own research grants;
- Scanned copy of doctorate certificate;
- Signed nomination letters from two established senior scientists.

### Schedule:

Open for nomination: 1 March 2023;  
Nomination deadline: 1 October 2023;  
Winner announcement: 20 December 2023.
