## 2023 EARLY CAREER-WOMEN AWARD

### Prizes:

- CHF 1000;
- A chance to publish a paper free of charge in *Membranes* in 2024 after peer review;
- An electronic certificate.

### Eligibility and Requirements:

- Nominees should be female early-career scientists with untenured positions, who are within 10 years prior to 31 December 2023 of completing their PhD.
- Nominees must have produced ground-breaking research and made a significant contribution to the field of membranes.

### List of Documents for Nomination:

- Detailed curriculum vitae, including an updated publication list and a list of awarded research grants;
- Scanned copy of doctorate or medical certificate, or equivalent and its translation (if applicable);
- Signed nomination letters from two established senior researchers.

### Schedule:

- Open for Nominations: 25 April 2023.
- Nomination deadline: 31 October 2023.
- Winner announcement: 20 December 2023.
