We are pleased to announce that *Micromachines* is now inviting nominations for the *Micromachines* 2023 Young Investigator Award. This prize will be given to one young investigator in recognition of their excellence in the field of micro/nano-scaled structures, materials, devices, and systems and their applications. All nominations will be assessed by an Evaluation Committee led by the Editor-in-Chief.

The Prize:

- CHF 2000;
- Option to publish one paper free of charge in *Micromachines* after peer review before the end of 2024;
- An electronic certificate.

Eligibility and Requirements:

- Must have received their PhD no more than 10 years prior to 31 December 2023;
- Must have produced ground-breaking research and a significant contribution to the advancement of research field;
- Must be nominated by senior scientists.

List of Documents for Nomination:

- Detailed Curriculum Vitae, including an updated publication list and a list of the researcher's own research grants;
- Scanned copy of doctorate certificate;
- Signed nomination letters from two established senior scientists.

Schedule:

- Open for nomination: 31 March 2023
- Nomination deadline: 30 November 2023
- Winner announcement: 31 January 2024
