## 2023 YOUNG INVESTIGATOR AWARD

Dear Colleagues,

We are pleased to announce that we are now inviting nominations for the *Microorganisms* 2023 Young Investigator Award. This prize will be given to three young investigators in recognition of their excellence in the field of microbiology research. All nominations will be assessed by an Evaluation Committee consisting of senior scholars from the *Microorganisms* Editorial Board.

### **The Prize:**

There will be three winners this year, and each will receive the following:

- CHF 1000;
- An opportunity to publish one paper free of charge in *Microorganisms* after peer review before the end of 2024;
- An electronic certificate.

### **Nomination Requirements for Candidates:**

- Must have received their PhD no more than 10 years prior to 31 December 2023;
- Must have produced ground-breaking research and made a significant contribution to the advancement of microbiology;
- Must be nominated by senior scientists.

### **List of Documents for Nomination:**

- Detailed curriculum vitae, including an updated publication list and a list of the researcher's own research grants;
- Scanned copy of doctorate certificate;
- Signed nomination letters from two established senior scientists.

### **Schedule:**

- Open for nominations: 20 April 2023
- Nomination deadline: 31 December 2023
- Winner announced: 31 March 2024
