This work, directed mainly towards protozoan neglected tropical diseases, seeks to establish starting points for future drug discovery campaigns.

He is planning to present his work "Click Chemistry Tools to Unravel New Targets in Malaria" at GP2A, Nottingham, UK. The award consists of 400 Swiss Francs to attend this conference.
