Dr. Qi (Tony) Zhou is an University Faculty Scholar Associate Professor of the Department of Industrial and Physical Pharmacy at Purdue University, West Lafayette, USA. Dr. Zhou's research interests are in particle engineering for innovative manufacturing of solids, the advanced characterization of pharmaceutical solid dosage forms, and the novel formulation design for pulmonary drug delivery systems. Dr. Zhou received his PhD in 2012 from Monash University of Australia and has an outstanding publication record, comprising >100 publications in peer-reviewed international journals and 9 international patents/patent applications. He is clearly a rising star in the field of pharmaceuticals with numerous international awards. Dr. Zhou is an Editor of AAPS PharmSciTech and Editorial Board Member of many pharmaceutical journals. He has secured funding of more than USD 8 million since 2013, which is an outstanding achievement in today's competitive environment.
