This prize will be given to one young investigator in recognition of their excellence in the field of pharmaceutics and biopharmaceutics. All nominations will be assessed by an Evaluation Committee led by the Editor-in-Chief, Prof. Dr. Yvonne Perrie.

# **The Prize**

- 2000 CHF (Swiss Francs);
- Option to publish one paper free of charge in *Pharmaceutics* after peer review before the end of 2023;
- An electronic certificate.

## **Eligibility and Requirements**

- Must have completed a PhD no more than 10 years prior to 31 December 2022;
- Must have produced ground-breaking research and made a significant contribution to the advancement of pharmaceutics and biopharmaceutics;
- Must be nominated by senior scientists.

## List of Documents for Nomination

- Detailed curriculum vitae, including an updated publication list and a list of the researcher's own research grants;
- Scanned copy of doctorate certificate;
- Signed nomination letters from two established senior scientists.

## Schedule

- Open for nominations: 25 March 2022
- Nomination deadline: 31 December 2022
- Winner announcement: 20 March 2023
