His research is related to polymer science, mainly focusing on elastic–plastic transition of transient semiflexible polymer networks, morphology of active polymer networks, and mechanic responses of magnetic elastomers under external magnetic fields. He will attend the 5th International Soft Matter Conference (ISMC 2019), held on 3–7 June 2019, in Edinburgh, UK.

They will be awarded 800 Swiss Francs each towards their travel expenses to attend the conferences. We congratulate the winners for their accomplishments.
