2023 YOUNG INVESTIGATOR AWARD

The Prizes:

- CHF 2000;
- Option to publish one paper free of charge in *Processes* after peer review before the end of July 2024;
- An electronic certificate.

Eligibility and Requirements:

- Must have received their PhD no more than 10 years prior to 31 December 2023;
- Must have produced ground-breaking research and made a significant contribution to the advancement of the chemistry, biochemistry, biology, materials, or related process/systems engineering research fields;
- Candidates must be nominated by senior scientists.

List of Documents for Nomination:

- Detailed curriculum vitae, including an updated publication list and a list of the researcher's own research grants;
- Scanned copy of doctorate certificate;
- Signed nomination letters from two established senior scientists.

Schedule:

Open for nominations: 13 January 2023;
Nomination deadline: 31 July 2023;
Winner announcement: 30 September 2023.
