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Message from the Guest Editors

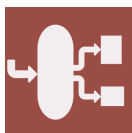

For a reliable industrial-scale reactor design, all this information must be employed in appropriate equations and mathematical models that allow for accurate and reliable simulations for the purposes of scaling up. The aim of this proposed Special Issue is to collect worldwide contributions from experts in the field of industrial reactor design based on kinetic and mass-transfer studies. - Pilot plant and industrial size reactors simulation and scale-up based on kinetic studies (lab-to-plant approach)
