Dr. Wenbo Peng is an Associate Professor at the School of Microelectronics, Xi'an Jiaotong University. Dr. Peng's research interests mainly focus on advanced low-dimensional piezoelectric semiconductor materials, devices and physics, contact electrification, triboelectric electronics and optoelectronics, and novel intelligent functional sensors. Dr. Peng received his PhD in 2016 and has an outstanding publication record, comprising over 50 publications in peer-reviewed international journals and over 2400 citations.

Dr. Peng's Hirsch index is 26. He is clearly a rising star in the field of sensors. As a single applicant, Dr. Peng has secured funding of more than EUR 200,000 since 2017.
