This prize will be given to one young investigator in recognition of their excellence in the field of sensors. All nominations will be assessed by an Award Evaluation Committee led by the journal's Editor-in-Chief, Prof. Dr. Vittorio M. N. Passaro.

The Prize:

- CHF 2000;
- The opportunity to publish one paper free of charge in Sensors following peer review before the end of 2025;
- An electronic certificate.

Eligibility and Requirements:

- The nominee must have received their Ph.D. no more than 10 years prior to 31 December 2024;
- The nominee must have produced ground-breaking research and made a significant contribution to the advancement of sensors;
- Candidates must be nominated by senior scientists.

List of Documents for Nomination:

- Detailed curriculum vitae, including an updated publication list and a list of the researcher's own research grants;
- A scanned copy of the nominee's doctorate certificate;
- Signed nomination letters from two established senior scientists.

Schedule:

- Nomination deadline: 31 December 2024;
- Winner announcement: 31 March 2025.
