- Must have received their PhD no more than 10 years prior to 31 December 2024;
- Must have produced ground-breaking research and made a significant contribution to the advancement of Social Sciences;
- Candidates must be nominated by senior scientists.

List of Documents for Nomination

- Detailed Curriculum Vitae, including an updated publication list and a list of the researcher's own research grants;
- Scanned copy of doctorate certificate;
- Signed nomination letters from two established senior scientists.

Schedule

- Nomination deadline: 31 December 2024
- Winner announcement: 31 March 2025
